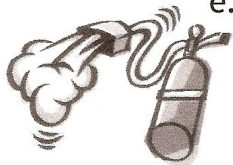

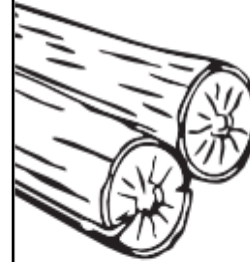

Black and Gold

After a month of what seems like endless rain, we have started to see our environment waking up as the mornings have become brighter and the evenings longer. Plants are starting to sprout from the soil and animals are waking from their long winter sleep. The children at our school are looking forward to warmer weather activities and new possibilities that a little bit more sunshine will bring.

Reception and Nursery have started off the half term with a topic of 'Who are our real like heroes?'. We are learning about people who help us. We have a visit from the RNLI, a coastguard and Beacon vets planned. The children are getting very good at identifying how people help each other in different ways.

Year 1 and 2 have started their new topic "How are Mexico and the United Kingdom different?" They will be comparing the human and physical geography of the United Kingdom to that of Mexico. They are also very excited about visiting the Eden Project and learning about plants that grow in hotter climates.

Year 3 and 4 have had an exciting few weeks of hands-on learning across the curriculum! As part of our Anglo-Saxon topic, the children took part in a fun treasure hunt in the Outdoor Learning Area searching for hidden "grave goods" and exploring what these items tell us about life in early Britain. In Design and Technology, we've launched our new topic on breads, where pupils will be learning about different ingredients and preparing to design their own delicious loaf. In Science, the class have been busy carrying out practical investigations into states of matter, observing how materials change when heated, cooled, or mixed. It's been a wonderfully active start to the term, with lots of curiosity and creativity on display!

This term, Year 5 and 6 are diving into an exciting new topic all about Food and Fairtrade. We'll be exploring where our food comes from, how it's produced, and why Fairtrade matters for farmers and communities around the world.

As part of our learning, we're really looking forward to visiting Woodland Valley Farm, where we'll be able to see local sustainable projects in action. The trip will help us understand how food is grown responsibly and how we

can trace ingredients from farm to fork. It's set to be an inspiring and thought-provoking topic, and we can't wait to get started!

Our Year 6 students ventured off to London for four days as part of their annual residential to an urban environment. They stayed in the historic HMS Belfast right next to Tower Bridge and the Tower of London. We'd like to thank the Victory Hall for letting us use their facilities before we set off early at 7am. The children visited the Imperial War Museum and reflected on the plight of soldiers, explored the Tower of London, visited the Houses of Parliament and met our MP Noah Law, took a ride on the London Eye, joined in with interactive displays in the Science Museum and Wonderlab, enjoyed Matilda the Musical as well as experiencing life in our capital city by riding on the Underground. Year 6 had a great time with lots of memories made.

We're looking forward to telling you more about our learning adventures next month.
